The route

- 1. From the corner between the Tourist Office and the Wine House, take the « rue des Ecoles ».
- 2. At the end of the street, turn right and cross the gate Saint-Martin.

Go on until the « give way » sign. Notice on your left the iron gate of Château Canon, dismount your bike and take on your right the one-way street. Continue following the low walls (beware of the traffic).

- 3. At the junction (château Canon sign), continue straight to reach the entrance of château Beau Séjour Bécot (towards Canon, Beau Séjour Bécot, cimetière).
- 4. Go straight on at the entrance of château Beau Séjour Bécot, walking along the house (towards « Boucle de Mazerat par Coutet »).

Take the littke track behind the château on the right and follow the green markings straight on until the trees clump overlooking the valley.

5. At the trees, ride along them until the end of the path and turn right.

Then go down the first track on the left (towards point de vue remarquable, camping, aire de repos).

- 6. Use the first path on the right between the vines (Franc Mayne sign).
- 7. You end up in front of so-called Gallo-roman furrows. Leave them on your right riding along the trees. Then turn immediately right after the trees on the grassy path.

8. At the bottom of this track go down a little path on the left following the green marking. Then continue on the right, go along the building of château Franc Pourret until the road D243. Cross the road and reach château Ambe Tour Pourret in front of you (beware of the traffic). Then continue on the tarred road going along château Vieux Pourret.

You reach château Côtes de Baleau (green signposts).

- 9. Turn left and continue straight on the grassy path. Or turn right to shorten the loop and reach n°13 on the left.
- 10. At the green marking, turn right. Then go on straight until the tarred road.
- 11. Once you reach the road, turn right.
- 12. Then take the first road on your right situated just after an abandonned building.

Continue straight up to the château Fonroque.

13. At château Fonroque turn left on the small path to cross the estate.

Then continue straight to reach the tarred road.

- 14. Once at the road turn right and go on straight until you reach road D122.
- 15. At road D122 turn right and continue straight until you reach the village (beware of the traffic).

Discover Saint-Emilion vineyard by bike. This short ride of **7 km** will help you to understand better what is Saint-Emilion wine and especially the organic wine.


Made of small tracks and woody areas, this route would please everyone! The circuit can be shortened (5.5 km).
